## Requirements

Any field of research is accepted!

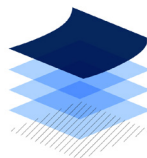
- Must be about either work in progress, an original project idea, or a paper already published.
- Must strongly highlight how Reaxys (and other) scientific databases helped (or can help) you to achieve your research goals.
- Must be between 750 and 1500 words.
- Must have a title and be easily readable also by chemists working in other research fields.
- Must have a bibliography.



## Submissions

Should include:

- Essay
- Academic CV
- PhD proof\*
- Awards and Certificates (optional but encouraged)



\*A certificate released by your university stating when you started the PhD or when you defended your thesis (final exam). We will welcome people who still have to defend the PhD thesis or defended it in 2018 or 2019.

## Timelines 2019

- **May 20:** Submission/ trial period starts.
- **May 28-29:** Meet us at the Biannual Meeting of the RSEQ in Donostia-San Sebastián
- **June 26:** Free webinar: Using Reaxys: Search for chemistry data and literature.
- **July 10:** Free webinar: Reaxys Medicinal Chemistry: Using accurate extracted bioactivity data to answer all medicinal chemistry related questions.
- **September 15:** Submission/ trial period ends.
- **November 5-8:** Award Ceremony at the Annual Meeting of the Young Researchers Division of the RSEQ in Valencia.
